The Major Faculties.

Each faculty will cover one academic year, which will consist of ten months with holidays during Ramadhan and the Hajj period. The new academic year 2008 will start in October, inshaAllah.

Years of study.

The first year will concentrate solely on Arabic language acquisition. The 'al-Arabi li al-Nasheen' series will be employed which is a set of six books which is taught in many institutions throughout the world. The book contains all the necessary grammar and etymology that is necessary to progress to a good level of overall comprehension. The basic grammar primer (nahw) will also be covered *al-Ajrumiyyah*.

Second Year will include the study of fiqh texts including Noor al-Idah, Maraqia al-Falah, al-Qudoori together with marginal notes from the Hashiyat ibn-Aabideen. Also Ilm al-Usool al-Fiqh by Shaykh Abdul Wahhab Khalaf. Grammer from Qatr al-Nida.

The following four remaining years will cover : in year three fiqh from al-Hidayah and selections from other texts. Intermediate and advanced Arabic literature.

Year four, Aqeeda, Usool al-Fiqh & Mantiq. Five, Hadith & Mustalah Hadith. And the final year, year six, will cover Quran tafseer and it's sciences

ADVANCED ISLAMIC STUDIES COURSE (AL-AALIMIYYAH)

Darul Arqam : Musa'ib ibn Umayr Islamic Shari'ah School.

The Prophet of Islam (Upon on Whom be Peace) said :

“If a man dies, his good deeds are discontinued, except for three : an ongoing charity, knowledge from which people benefit, or a good offspring praying for him.”

Education has always been traditionally viewed as being from the most noble of occupations. The person involved in it's dissemination is considered to be equivalent to the warrior in the battle field and as long as people benefit from that knowledge it remains a form of continuous charity benefiting the teacher and all those who assisted the teacher. For this reason as far back as the Umayyad period , within the first century of Islam, traditional Islamic schools were founded. These were established by private individuals for the benefit of the Muslim community particularly and all of human kind generally.

The school will attempt to teach some of the most authoritative texts in the various branches of the Islamic sciences gradually progressing from the primary didactic text (*al-Matn*) to the more advanced texts consisting of the commentaries (*al-Sharah*) and making use of the glosses and marginal notes (*al-Hawashi*).

In total it will be a six year programme, the first year concentrating solely on the acquisition of the Arabic language using English as the medium of instruction and thereafter progressing solely to the Arabic medium.

The course will run in the evenings enabling students to participate who otherwise have commitments during the day. The course will also, selectively, accept applications from children in their teens if they show the correct acumen and maturity.

The Mus'aib bin Umayr school is a first of it's kind in that it will attempt to teach the traditional '*al-aalamiyyah*' syllabus in Arabic.
