Children's Quranic & Islamic Studies School

Quranic and Islamic studies course which aims to instil a love of the book of Allah and Islam by emphasizing self reformation and seeking to gain praiseworthy characteristics of the Prophet (upon whom be peace). The subjects taught include history of the Prophets continuing to the end of the rightly guided caliphs, Islamic beliefs in a subtle and interactive way, good manners and morals (aqhlaaq) and how to perform bodily aspects of worship (fiqh). There will also be a period set aside where children will be encouraged to recite litanies from the Prophetic Sunnah and recite salutations upon the Prophet (upon whom be peace).

The Books that will be utilised during the course of the '3 to 1 Quran School' are :

Ahsan al-Qawi'd أحسن القواعد. Once students have demonstrated a level of proficiency using this primary text and completed it students will move on to the Quran itself. The method adopted by the أحسن القواعد is a famous system used to teach the reading of Arabic to children and other books such as القاعدة البغدادية al-Qai'da al-Baghdadiyah, which are used in the Middle East, also adopt the same system. Use will be made also of flipcharts and flash cards enabling recognition of the words in the initial, medial and final forms. Beginners Tajweed will also be taught. Memorisation of du'as and litanies will also take place in this period.

al-Thadhib التهذيب و الأخلاق printed by the Islamic Education Organization of South Africa (IEOSA). The volume that will be utilised will be according to age and aptitude. While the books mentioned will be used we hope to also use instructional stories taken direct from the Arabic sources, appreciating that stories hold a captivating power which instructions do not. Part of the Quranic paradigm of 'ahsan al-Qisas' أحسن القصص that instruction to higher ideals be both direct and subtle.

al-Tareekh كتاب التاريخ, printed by IEO starting from stories concerning the Prophets (upon whom be peace) and concluding with the demise of the last of the rightly guided caliphs (may Allah be please with them all). The emphasis will be on drawing of lessons from their lives not merely recalling important dates and events.

العقيدة al-Aqeeda (Beliefs) will be taught using 'We are Muslims', IQRA Educational Foundation of USA. However, the title will be supplemented by stories from our rich heritage of instructional material. Multimedia sources will also be used in the various subjects subject to time and relevance.

Tasheel al-Fiqh تسهيل الفقه, Majlis al-Ulama, Transvaal, South Africa. Basic Fiqh using both the book and demonstrations.

Lessons will take place three days a week with two groups each for the boys and girls. DA will decide which class the child will join after consultation with the parents. The different days are Mon, Wed, Fri or Tues, Thurs, Sat with male and female teachers present for both groups of days. The class sizes will be set at 3 children. The Timetable :

Entrance Requirements

The course will be open to children from the age of five and no previous Islamic studies is assumed although being able to recite the Arabic alphabet will be a distinct advantage.

Sheikh Zakarya Bin Yahya

Sheikh Zakarya Bin Yahya has had the honour of studying at some of the most renowned seminaries in the Indian sub-continent and has received tutelage in the sacred Islamic Sciences from teachers with chains of narrations in the classical disciplines who are of great academic and spiritual repute. Sheikh Zakarya initially started his education in his home town in Algeria where he was born and raised thereafter he continued his studies at the Islamic University: Madrasa Arabiya in Raiwind, Pakistan. He then continued his studies of the Islamic sciences at Darul uloom, Faisalabad and later graduated in Jamia Islamiya, Binnuri Town Karachi (Daratul Hadeeth). As a result of being classically trained in the sacred sciences Sheikh Zakarya has formal qualifications in Tajweed, Arabic language and grammar, Hadith, Maliki Fiqh & Maliki Usul. After completing his studies he then spent 3 years in France teaching the Quran and Arabic language to the Arab communities. Sheikh Zakarya has now relocated to the UK, and being a specialist in the field of Arabic language and grammar, now teaches Qur'anic Arabic to mature students and adults.

Ustadha Safiya Mulla

Memorised the complete Quran an endeavour which took more than four years.
