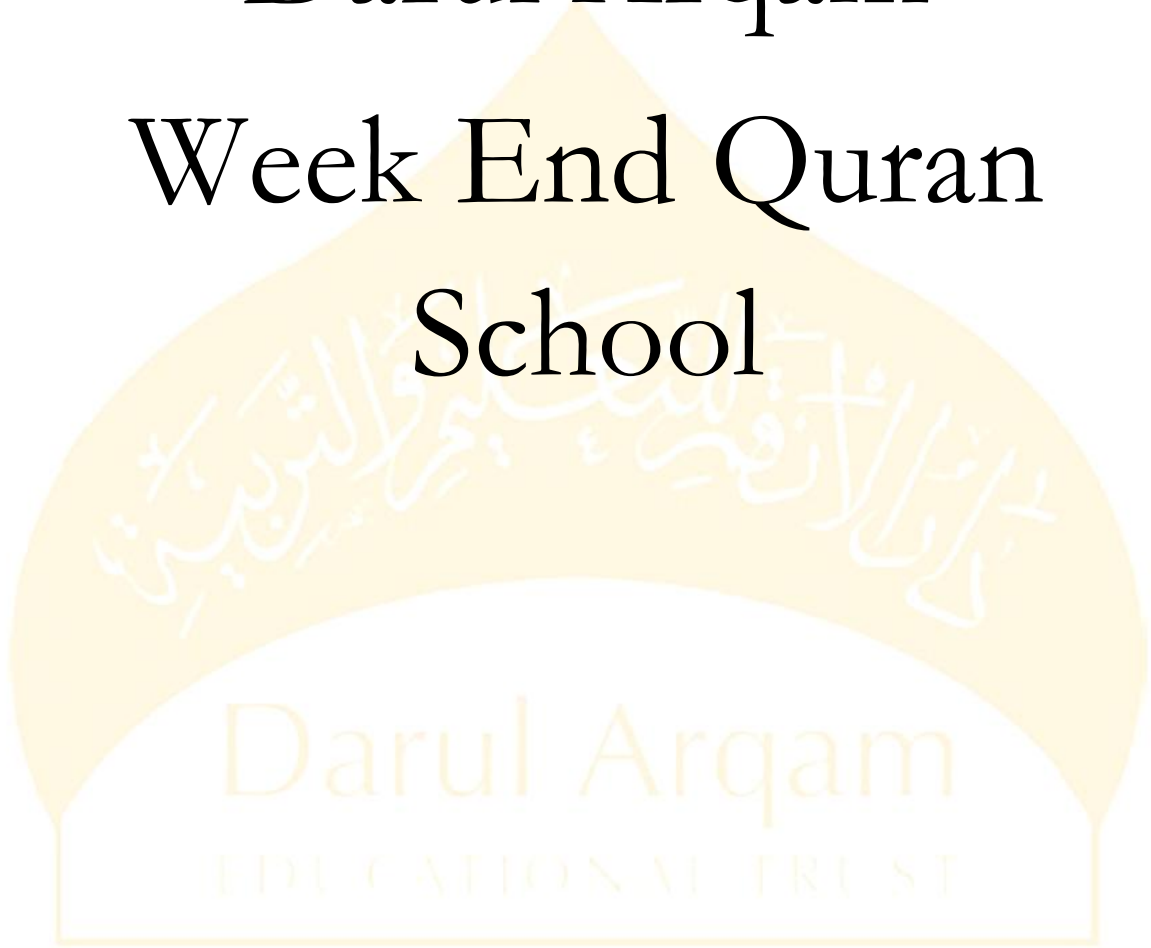

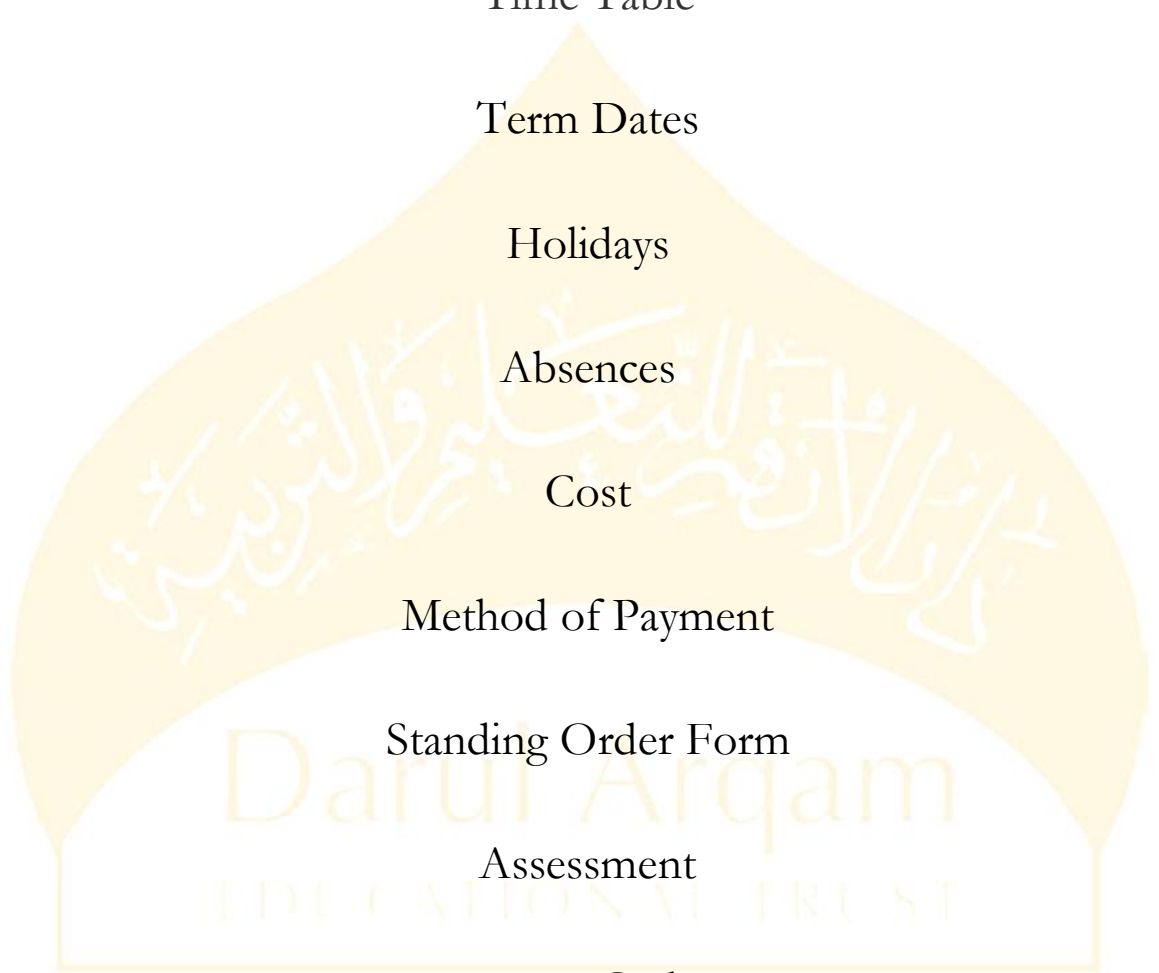

The Week End Quran School

The Week End Quran School aims to instil a love of the book of Allah and Islam by emphasizing self reformation and seeking to gain praiseworthy characteristics of the Prophet (upon whom be peace). Furthermore, to introduce, in a subtle and interactive way: Islamic manners and morals, how to perform bodily aspects of worship, our glorious history, and Islamic beliefs.

The Texts That Will Be Taught

The Books that will be utilised during the course of the 'Weekend Quran School' are: **Ahsan al-Qawi'd**, also known as the 'al-Qai'da al-Baghdadiyah', which is also used in the Middle East. Once students have demonstrated a level of proficiency using this primary text and completed it students will move on to the **Quran** itself. Flipcharts and flash cards enabling recognition of the words in the initial, medial and final forms.

Beginners Tajweed will also be taught.

Other subjects include: **Fiqh & Ibadat, Islamic History and Sirah** will be supplemented by the IQRA' International Educational Foundation Syllabus and books. Teaching will take place using ICT and Media, along with engaging activities and worksheets.

Furthermore, the memorisation of **du'as and litanies** will also take place using a simple book designed for beginners and children.

Cost

The Weekend Quran School costs £40 per month and we require a minimum of a 3 month commitment.

Methods of Payment

Assessments

The Students will be assessed with regards to their progress by the method of oral examination and the older children will be required to do additional written exams. This assessment will take place on 16th July 2011. At the end of the year we will provide you with an annual report card of your child's performance and progress. Dress Code

There is no formal uniform or dress code, but we do encourage children to dress in Islamic attire (i.e. boys in thobes and Fez [topi]; and girls in hijab). However girls 14+ are strongly advised to dress in abaya and hijab.
